Introductions and Welcome

Speakers:

Leslie Gleason, Executive Director, Trinity Center gave an overview of the services available at Trinity Center. They have been seeing average attendance increase from an average of 67 to 71 clients daily. As new clients access Trinity, they work with a member advocate to compete an intake process. Services include case management, warming/cooling room, laundry, food, storage lockers with access to an electrical outlet, mail access, package delivery, and internet access to help in job searches and such. Loaves and Fishes provides the food. Medical care is also available including vaccination clinics and access to a doctor to help sort out health care needs. Trinity has transition youth services for youth from about 18 to 24 aging out of foster care. In additional Trinity operates a winter shelter at the Walnut Creek Armory from Dec to April.

The increasing number of clients presents challenges such as conflicts with other uses at St Paul's so Trinity is looking at satellite locations. *All are welcome to attend Trinity's annual fundraiser at Ruth Bancroft Gardens on June 15th...don't miss it!*
